Statement from the Integrity Commission

The Integrity Commission of Trinidad and Tobago at its regular meeting this morning, March 31, 2015, noted the recent allegations made in the Parliament of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago that have given rise to public unease. The Commission urges all Members of Parliament (being Persons in Public Life) to exercise restraint and balance and invites all Members of Parliament to observe the preamble of the Integrity in Public Life Act which is intended “to regulate the conduct of persons exercising public functions; to preserve and promote the integrity of public officials and institutions.”
