**To all persons in Public Life as defined by
The Integrity in Public Life Act, Chapter 22: 01**

The Integrity Commission of Trinidad and Tobago will publish a list of persons in public life who have failed to comply with their duty to file declarations for the period **2003 to 2014** in accordance with the section 11(6) of the Integrity in Public Life Act (IPLA) on or before **May 27, 2016**.

Section 11(6) of the Integrity in Public Life Act, Chap. 22: 01 states:

Section 11 (6)- “Where a person who is required to do so fails to file a declaration in accordance with this section or without reasonable cause, fails to furnish particulars in accordance with section 13 or fails to file the statement of registrable interests under section 14, the Commission shall publish such fact in the Gazette and at least one daily newspaper in circulation in Trinidad and Tobago”.

The Commission wishes to remind persons in public life that all outstanding Declarations of Income, Assets and Liabilities and Statements of Registrable Interests as required by Sections 11(1) and 14(1) of the *Integrity in Public Life Act, Chapter 22: 01* are to be submitted to the Commission without further delay.

The Commission provides consultative facilities in a confidential environment to assist declarants to comply with their statutory obligations.
