## THE DO RIGHT POSTER DESIGN PROJECT

The Integrity Commission of Trinidad and Tobago, as part of its mandate to promote standards of Integrity, have for the past five years engaged students of Primary and Secondary Schools in 'Do Right Champion' competitions that take advantage of the school's embedded curricular - specifically the English Language Arts and the Visual and the Visual and Performing Arts. All activities have been successfully implemented in collaboration with the Ministry of Education and the Division of Education, Youth Affairs and Sport of the Tobago House of Assembly.

For the 2016-2017 School Year, the Commission invites senior students of Secondary Schools in Trinidad and Tobago to register and design a poster on the theme of Integrity and Ethics in a visually attractive and meaningful way. At the secondary level, in most schools, students are exposed to a minimum of two disciplines of the Visual and Performing Arts as well as to the English Language Arts.

The Secondary School Do Right Poster Design Project will be launched at the National Museum and Art Gallery on September 16th 2016.

The Integrity Commission will facilitate arrangements for all entries to be juried.

The most deserving submission from each school will be digitally photographed, enlarged and printed on vinyl fabric for display.

The Commission will unveil the best entries at a ceremony scheduled to take place at the National Museum and Art Gallery in 2017.

The enlarged posters will thereafter form part of a travelling exhibition at venues around the nation, on Social Media as well as on the Commission's Website. Schools may enlarge the posters for placement on walls or on community spaces. The Commission is of the view that this School Poster Design Project will communicate opinion and pride in the school community about issues related to Ethics, Integrity our culture and heritage.

## PROJECT GUIDELINES

Senior Art Teachers at all Secondary Schools are encouraged to attend the project launch on Friday September 16th 2016. The Hon. Minister of Education is expected to attend.

Schools have until October 14th 2016 to Register with the Integrity Commission and thereafter submit a Poster on the theme and a 250-word description of the design. November 11th 2016 is the deadline for the receipt of Posters at the Education District Office.

Students are invited to brainstorm ideas on the theme "Do Right" to create and design a Poster.

### SUGGESTED TOPICS

- "DO RIGHT" in schools, in the community
- With the poor, the elderly
- Keeping parks and environment clean
- Being alert and watchful in neighborhoods with regard to crime
- Visiting the sick, destitute and dying
- Avoiding conflicts and fights
- Maintaining a mannerly attitude
- Giving great consideration and attention to personal education
- Being honest and kind
- Not shirking responsibility
- Exercising fair play in sports
- Demonstrating honesty and integrity
- Conscious of proper deportment on the nation's streets
- Showing respect to elders
- Mindful of the needs of the elderly and children

Students, with teacher supervision, are urged to translate ideas on the theme of Integrity into pictorials using a variety of materials and media.

Teachers may opt to have groupings of students collaborate on a design as some may have strong detail ideas which when put together may allow for a more successful design.

Various materials may be used to make a Poster (coloured version to scale), Paints (water colour, poster and acrylic) Collage, Paper, Fabric, Natural Fiber, Photographs or Maps (tissue, magazine print, markers, pencils and pastels) Material (collages, fabric, natural fibers).

Each school is allowed to put forward **one comprehensive poster** design on the theme of Ethics and Integrity.

A selection of the **best poster design** from all students in a school can be made by art **teachers or a panel of jurors** from within the school.

3

The final poster design **must be properly mounted** and securely packaged for submission.

4

A **250-word description of the process** engaged by students and teachers in producing the design **must be submitted along with the Poster** to the Education District Office **no later than November 11th 2016.**

## AGREEMENT

By submitting a Poster Design and 250-word description to the Ministry of Education's District Office, school principals agree that it conforms to the Guidelines as detailed.

All School Poster Designs should be relevant to our local art forms and ought not to denigrate, offend or violate another's rights in any way.

By entering the **Do Right School Poster Project** students, teachers and schools give The Integrity Commission of Trinidad and Tobago the right to use the images and material submitted in any and all advertising, promotion and communications of the Commission. These include:

Print advertisements; websites, social media of any kind, dissemination of videos; further use of design(s) as desired, publication of the names and faces of the creators and participants in the production of the Schools' Poster Project.
