# **“Do Right Champion” Poster Design Project for Secondary Schools**

The Integrity Commission of Trinidad and Tobago will be launching its 2016/17 “Do Right Champion” Poster Design Project for Secondary Schools at the National Museum and Art Gallery in Port of Spain on September 16<sup>th</sup> 2016 at 9.30 a.m. This year’s Poster Design Project seeks to engage students in designing a Poster on the theme of “Integrity and Ethics” in a visually attractive and meaningful way together with a 250- word description of the design.

In the past five years the Integrity Commission, in collaboration with the Ministry of Education and the Division of Education, Youth Affairs and Sport of the Tobago House of Assembly, has successfully implemented the “Do Right Champion” projects that took advantage of the schools embedded curricular - specifically the English Language Arts and the Visual and Performing Arts.

To this end, the Integrity Commission has invited the Minister of Education, the Honourable Anthony Garcia to launch the project.

The unveiling of the successful entries is scheduled to take place at the National Museum and Art Gallery in March 2017. The posters will thereafter form part of a travelling exhibition at venues around country, the Integrity Commission’s Social Media and Website. The School Poster Design Project is aimed to communicate opinion and pride in the school communities on issues related to Ethics, Integrity, our culture and heritage.

Guidelines for the Do Right Champion Poster Design Project have been forwarded to all Secondary School Principals.

All Poster Designs must be submitted to the Ministry of Education District Offices by **November 11<sup>th</sup> 2016**.
