

NOTICE

TO ALL PERSONS IN PUBLIC LIFE AS DEFINED BY THE INTEGRITY IN PUBLIC LIFE ACT, CHAPTER 22:01

The Integrity Commission notifies all 'Persons in Public Life' that they have an obligation to file their declarations of income, assets and liabilities and statements of registrable interests for the year ended December 31, 2010 by May 31, 2011 in accordance with Sections 11 (1) and 14 (1) of the Integrity in Public Life Act. The Act states:

Section 11 (1) "A person shall, within three months of becoming a person in public life, complete and file with the Commission in the prescribed form, a declaration of his income, assets and liabilities that exceed ten thousand dollars in value in respect of the previous year and, thereafter, on 31st May in each succeeding year that he is a person in public life, he shall file further declarations of his income, assets and liabilities that exceed ten thousand dollars in value".

Section 14 (1) "A person in public life shall file with his declaration under section 11, an additional statement of registrable interests in the prescribed form, which shall contain the information required by sub-section (3)".

Persons in public life are set out below:

- 1 Members of the House of Representatives
- 2 Ministers of Government
- 3 Parliamentary Secretaries
- 4 Members of the Tobago House of Assembly
- 5 Members of Municipalities
- 6 Members of Local Government Authorities
- 7 Senators
- 8 Members of the Boards of all Statutory Bodies and State Enterprises, including those bodies in which the State has a controlling interest
- 9 Permanent Secretaries and Chief Technical Officers

The Commission wishes to remind persons in public life that all outstanding Declarations of Income, Assets and Liabilities and Statements of Registrable Interests are to be submitted without further delay.

The prescribed forms are contained in Regulations published as Legal Notice No. 216 of 2003 in the supplement of the Trinidad and Tobago Gazette, dated December 12, 2003.

The forms can now be obtained on line by accessing the Integrity Commission's website at www.integritycommission.org.tt or may be collected at the Office of the Integrity Commission, 4th Floor, UTC Financial Centre, Independence Square, Port of Spain.
