



RESULTS OF THE ‘DO RIGHT CHAMPIONS’ TO BE RELEASED IN JANUARY

The Integrity Commission of Trinidad and Tobago extends congratulations to all students and teachers who responded to the challenge of our 2012 “Do Right Champions” competition in Short Story and Drawing. The Commission expects teachers’ and students to continue relentlessly to spread the message of integrity.

The Commission is pleased to report that the judges have completed a review of over 575 entries from 140 schools spread across all education districts in Trinidad and Tobago. The results of the “Do Right Champions” competition will be made available to schools at the start of the school term in January 2013 following which prizes and awards will be presented to students.

The Integrity Commission remains of the view that this competition among students of our Primary and Secondary Schools, now in its second year, reflects upon the academic quality of our schools, student abilities and teacher talent. It reflects also upon school leadership that encourages students to seek out educational challenges beyond traditional school walls.

Students of all private and public Primary and Secondary Schools in Trinidad and Tobago were invited from September to November to submit, at the level of each Standard or Form, the best Short Story and the best Drawing on the theme of Integrity. In the inaugural competition students were also invited to submit Poems and Scenario scripts (Skits).

The “Do Right Champions Competition” forms an integral part of the Integrity Commission’s mandate “to carry out programmes of public education intended to foster an understanding of the standards of Integrity.” The Ministry of Education and the Tobago House of Assembly collaborated with the Integrity Commission in facilitating arrangements for this year’s competition.

The Commission is heartened by the support and enthusiasm displayed by teachers, students and the cohort of experienced and retired teachers and curriculum officers who adjudicated on the 575 entries received in the competition.
